What is the Georgia Milestone/EOC Assessment???

- End of Course Test
- A state mandated test designed by the state...not your teacher, school or county.
- Teachers cannot look at the test nor answer any questions that you have about a question or its answers choices.

What Should I Bring to the Test?

- Two #2 pencils
- NO food, drinks or gum
 - Water is only permitted in a clear, plastic bottle and needs to be kept on the floor during the test.
- Blank paper will be provided if requested (you can use your test ticket as scratch paper)
 - Your name must be written on all papers and then turned back in to the teacher at the end of the test.
- A non-science book to read after you have completed and checked over your test



The EOCT is ALL business!

- This is a state test.
- Any disruption of any kind can lead to your scores being cancelled. (You will receive a “0” as your final exam score)
- You may not talk during any part of the test.
- You must raise your hand to leave your seat (sharpen pencils, get a tissue, etc.)
- All backpacks must be placed at the front of the room.
- ALL cell phones & electronic devices will be collected before the test begins and picked up after the test is over.



The EOCT is ALL business!

- Personal needs (i.e. bathroom, etc.) should be attended to before the test. You may only leave the testing room in the event of an emergency with a chaperone.
- When the test is done, you cannot ask the teacher anything about questions on the test.
- You should not discuss the test with your peers.
- You may not leave the room, even if you finish early. We will dismiss as a group.
